WHAT IS CAMOUFLAGE?

Camouflage is a tactic used by animals to protect themselves. Camouflage is when an animal's natural colors help it blend in with its surroundings. Think of it as a natural disguise for the animal. Prey (animals that are hunted by other animals) use it to hide from predators (animals that hunt). Predators also use camouflage to hide so they can sneak up on their prey.

CHAMELEONS




MAKE YOUR OWN CAMO CHAMELEON! MATERIALS:
