This month's project is inspired by our children book of the month selection, "Gabriella's Song." Music has a way of evoking a range of emotions and memories depending on the person and their own life experiences. It is with this in mind that you will create a small series of artworks, each inspired by different pieces of music.


As the focus of these works is on the emotions you feel, or maybe a specific memory the materials used will be kept simple. Begin by gathering a few pieces of sketching paper, a pencil, and crayons or colored pencils. You will also need a device to play the music that will inspire your art. We have chosen three songs for this project to demonstrate the variety that can come from the same piece of music. All pieces can be found on most streaming services or on YouTube.

We recommend listening to the song once, and then on the second listen pick up your drawing material of choice to begin creating. Repeat this step with each song. The result will be three unique drawings that are each a reflection of what the music has inspired. Doing this project with a friend or family member would also allow you each to compare your artwork, to see how you each interpreted the music differently or maybe had similarities.


