
Love is All Around


The corresponding art project for this month is inspired by our young adult book selection graphic novel format. Your starting point should be determining which love story in your life, either romantic or familial, is to be the foundation of your story.

To begin, take time to reflect on the story you plan to share and create a list of the key points you want to include. This will help provide an outline of not only the text but also the illustrations that will do a lot of the story telling. You will need several pieces of paper to create your graphic novel, though the total length will be up to you. It will be important to consider the medium your novel will be illustrated with to ensure you have the appropriate paper. We suggest using markers, pencil (graphite or colored), or ink as they will be easier to work with and create your final book.

Prior to finalizing the format of your graphic novel, take time to review not only the style Alice Oseman used in Heartstopper, but also other graphic novels available. The placement of the illustrations and their relation to the text will help inform the approach you take. For example, Oseman uses a very limited color palette for her illustrations and text which may not be of interest to you. However, she does use a variety of layouts which help create more visual interest as the reader moves through the pages.

While we want you to find inspiration from existing graphic novels, the final product should reflect the love story you're sharing and your own personal artistic and writing style. Don't forget to share your final project with us using #LymanAllynAtHome!






